**Farmington Gift Guide Financial Statement**

Ron Keeney reported there was \$16,477.83 left in the Farmington Gift Guide.

**Farmington Country Club Invitational**

Mike Millen reported that to date, thirteen teams had committed to play in the tournament. We would like to get commitments from 2 to 6 more teams. We still need prizes in groups of four. The balls, hats and golf shirts for the tournament have been ordered. Volunteers will be needed to work the registration table, the hospitality tables, to monitor the three par three holes for closest to the pin, and to sell raffle tickets on home #17. Brian Daly is providing pool passes from the City of Charlottesville for grab bags for the participant in the tournament. Birdwood is providing four rounds of golf as a prize.

## Chapter Updates and Events – June 2010 by Phillip Seay

- This Spring there were 20 Little Linksters and 124 The First Tee participants. We utilized both Meadowcreek Golf Course and McIntire Municipal Golf Park extensively. There were 144 participants at a golf fun day and pizza party held at McIntire Golf Course to conclude the session.
- In Summer I we have 26 Little Linksters, 85 The First Tee participants and 40 from Charlottesville Parks & Recreation and Camp Excel. Walker Elementary School participants and Tonsler Recreation participants will be joining
- Golf Card – Newsplex – (the network of channels ABC 16, CBS 19, and FOX 27) will be doing a card similar to the lung card that provides play for its holder at six courses (Massanutten Resort, Old Trail Golf Course, Packsaddle Ridge, Spring Creek, Stoney Creek and Wintergreen Resort) for special rates. The card will cost \$179.00 and some of the profits from the card will be donated to The First Tee of Charlottesville and to The First Tee of Harrisonburg.
- Military Voucher Program -Currently there are 25 participants taking advantage of this program. It reimburses The First Tee of Charlottesville \$75.00 for each participant.
- June 12<sup>th</sup>
  - The Golf Equipment and Rummage Sale brought in \$2,438.50. Money is still coming in from the sale of clubs.
  - Summer Meet & Greet had only a small group of parents and students attending.
  - Fun Run (5K Run/Walk) had about 30 participants . Started at The Catholic School and included three holes on Meadowcreek Golf Course. It was thoroughly enjoyed by all the participants. It was sponsored by Davenport and Company and netted about \$1,00.00. It may become an annual event.
- Partnership with First Citizens Tour
  - June 6<sup>th</sup>, Golf Tournament for beginners had 24 participants. Bruce Stoufford organized this very successful event. The parents or adults caddied for the participants and it was very much enjoyed. The hope is to have a similar event every 4 to 5 weeks.
