PROGRAMS OFFERED

The First Tee Life Skills Experience creates a youth-centered mastery climate in which young people are empowered to explore options and make decisions, two elements that are critical to the development of a child's value system.

The **TARGET** program is an introduction to the Life Skills Experience and basic golf instruction for the younger participants.

The **PLAYer** program is designed to expose participants of all ages and ability levels to the game of golf and its inherent values. **PLAYer** serves as the entry level into The First Tee Life Skills Experience certification process.

The First Tee Certification process involves exposure, reinforcement and application of the Life Skills core lessons and golf skills with playing requirements and the Rules of Golf.

Par: Ages 9+
